TARIFF FORMAT

- A. Page Numbering** - Page numbers appear in the upper right corner of the page. Pages are numbered sequentially. When a new page is added between pages already in effect, a decimal is added. For example, a new page added between pages 14 and 15 would be 14.1.
- B. Page Revision Numbers** - Revision numbers also appear in the upper right corner of each page. These numbers are used to determine the most current page version on file with the Pa. P.U.C. For example, the 4th revised Page 14 cancels the 3rd revised Page 14. Because of various suspension periods, deferrals, etc. the Pa. P.U.C. follows in its tariff approval process, the most current page number on file with the Commission is not always the tariff page in effect. Consult the Check Sheet for the page currently in effect.
- C. Check Sheets** - When a tariff filing is made with the Pa. P.U.C., an updated Check Sheet accompanies the tariff filing. The Check Sheet lists the pages contained in the tariff, with a cross reference to the current revision number. When new pages are added, the Check Sheet is changed to reflect the revision. All revisions made in a given filing are designated by an asterisk (*). There will be no other symbols used on this page if these are the only changes made to it (i.e., the format, etc. remain the same, just revised revision levels on some pages.)

This tariff sets forth the service offerings, rates, terms and conditions applicable to the furnishing of Message Toll Service by XO Communications Services, Inc., to Customers within the State of Pennsylvania. INTEREXCHANGE SERVICES TARIFF

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS

Certain terms used generally throughout this tariff are defined below.

Call Rounding - The price for each call will be rounded to the next highest penny.

Company - XO Communications Services, Inc. ("XO"), a Delaware corporation, which is the issuer of this tariff.

Dial Tone or Dedicated Access - Locations where the Company is providing the local dial tone, or dedicated access locations.

LATA - A local access and transport area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-0192 for the provision and administration of communications services.

Message Toll Service - A service that provides facilities for telecommunications between different local calling areas of the same LATA in accordance with the regulations and schedule of rates specified in this tariff. The rates specified in this tariff are in payment for all services furnished between the calling and called stations.

MOU - Minutes of use.

INTEREXCHANGE SERVICES TARIFF

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS, (CONT'D.)

Originating Off-Net - A call originating on and placed via non-Company owned or Company leased facilities.

Originating On-Net - A call originating on and placed via Company owned or Company leased local exchange facilities.

Station - The term "Station" denotes the network control signaling unit and any other equipment provided at the Customer's premises which enables the Customer to establish communications connections and to effect communications through such connections.

Station-to-Station - Service where the person originating the call from other than a public or semipublic coin telephone dials the telephone number desired and the call is completed without the assistance of the Company operator and the call is not billed to a number other than the originating number.

Switched Access - Locations where the local dial tone is being provided by someone (ILEC or CLEC) other than XO.

Toll Free Off-Net - Toll Free Service terminating on non-Company owned or Company leased local exchange facilities.

Toll Free On-Net - Toll Free Service terminating on Company owned or Company leased local exchange facilities.

Toll Free Service - Refers to 800 and 888 service.

INTEREXCHANGE SERVICES TARIFF

SECTION 2 - REGULATIONS

2.1 Undertaking of the Company

Please refer to the Company's Local Exchange Services Tariff, PA P.U.C. Tariff No. 9, for all applicable Regulations.

The Company offers, subject to the terms and conditions specified in this tariff, the use of its facilities where available for communications between Customers.

2.2 Priority of Service

In case a shortage of facilities exists at any time either for temporary or protracted periods, the furnishing of Message Toll Service will be furnished, in all cases, pursuant to any applicable federal or state prioritization requirements.

2.3 Liability of the Company

The liability of the Company for damages arising out of the furnishing of these services, including but not limited to mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors, other effects, representations, or use of these services or arising out of the failure to furnish the service, whether caused by acts of commission or omission, shall in no event exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the period of service during which such mistake, omission, interruption, delay, or error or defect in transmission, or failure or defect in the Company's equipment occurs. Adjustments within the limits provided herein may be made by direct payment to the Customer or by credit to the Customer's account.

INTEREXCHANGE SERVICES TARIFF

SECTION 2 - REGULATIONS, (CONT'D.)

2.4 Use

2.4.1 Service is provided for use by the Customer and may be used by others, when so authorized by the Customer, provided that all such usage shall be subject to the provisions of this tariff, and shall not affect the Customer's responsibility for all payments required under this tariff.

2.4.2 Use of Service for Unlawful Purposes

Service is furnished subject to the condition that it will not be used for an unlawful purpose. Service will not be furnished if any law enforcement agency, acting within its jurisdiction, advises that such service is being used or will be used in violation of the law, or if the Company receives other evidence that such service is or will be used for such purposes

2.4.3 Use of Service With Customer-Provided Equipment

Customer-provided terminal equipment and communications systems may be connected to exchange facilities of the Company subject to the regulations, rates and charges applicable to the facilities as provided for in the Company's tariffs.

2.5 Customer Specific Pricing (CSP)

Customer Specific Pricing arrangements for toll services provided in this tariff, can be furnished to meet the communications needs of specific customers on a case-by-case basis. Such toll services will be provided to customers on a contractual basis based on the following conditions:

CSP arrangements shall be made available only to customers who generate (or commit to) and maintain \$40,000 or more in annual Company total billed revenue.

Rates charged under CSP arrangements shall exceed the imputation test approved by the Commission in its Final Order at Docket No. R-953396C0001 so that equally efficient competitors could provide comparable services at those rates while purchasing service from the Company.

CSP arrangements shall be filed with the Commission under Proprietary Seal to become effective on one day's notice.

CSP rates shall be filed with the Commission for public inspection.

Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for such arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations specified in other sections of this tariff.

2.7 Special Construction

Subject to the arrangement of the Company and to all of the regulations contained in this tariff, special construction of facilities may be undertaken on a reasonable efforts basis at the request of the Customer. Special construction is that construction undertaken:

- (a) where facilities are not presently available, and there is not other requirement for the facilities so constructed;
- (b) of a type other than that which the Company would normally utilize in the furnishing of its services;
- (c) over a route other than that which the Company would normally utilize in the furnishing of its services;
- (d) in a quantity greater than that which the Company would normally construct;
- (e) on an expedited basis;
- (f) on a temporary basis until permanent facilities are available; involving abnormal costs; or in advance of its normal construction;
- (g) involving abnormal costs; or
- (h) in advance of its normal construction.

Special construction charges will be determined on a case by case basis.

The duration of each call will be rounded to the nearest higher increment for billing purposes. Additionally, fractional cents will be rounded to the nearest higher cent. (C)(I)

3.29 Public Telephone Surcharge

In order to recover the Company's expenses to comply with the FCC's pay telephone compensation plan effective on October 7, 1997 (FCC 97-371), an undiscountable per call charge is applicable to all interstate, intrastate and international calls that originate from any domestic pay telephone used to access the Company's services. This surcharge, which is in addition to standard tariffed usage charges and any applicable service charges and surcharges associated with the Company's service, applies for the use of the instrument used to access the Company's service and is unrelated to the service accessed from the pay telephone.

Pay telephones include coin-operated and coinless phones owned by local telephone companies, independent companies and other interexchange carriers. The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge applies to the initial completed call and any reoriginated call (i.e., using the A#@ symbol).

Whenever possible, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge will appear on the same invoice containing the usage charges for the surcharged call. In cases where proper pay telephone coding digits are not transmitted to the Company prior to completion of a call, the Public Pay Telephone Surcharge may be billed on a subsequent invoice after the Company has obtained information from a carrier that the originating station is an eligible pay telephone.

The Public Pay Telephone Surcharge does not apply to calls placed from pay telephones at which the Customer pays for service by inserting coins during the progress of the call.

In addition to the services offered in the bundle promotion, Customers will be billed at the following rates for usage of the following optional services:

International Service: Customers choosing Option Numbers One (1) through Four (4) and Seven (7) through Eleven (11) will be offered at rates set forth in the Platinum Small Business Plan in FCC No. 5. Customers choosing Option Numbers Five (5) and Six (6) will be offered at rates set forth in the Platinum Medium Business Plan in FCC No. 5.

Directory Assistance

Customer’s placing a Directory Assistance call as a XOption Customer will be charged the rate listed in Section 3.6.1 of this tariff for each call.

This promotion is available subject to the availability of facilities and only where technically feasible. In order to be eligible for this promotion, a New Customer must not have received telecommunications service from another Service Provider at the location to which the new XO services are provided, or the New Customer must switch back to the Service Provider that provided New Customer's telecommunications service prior to New Customer subscribing to the new XO service.

New Customer must notify XO, in writing (via certified or overnight delivery with signature) with the XO claim form no later than three (3) months from the date of Service installation and before contacting their previous provider, of its intent to discontinue the Services. New Customer must allow XO a minimum of 30 days from the day of New Customer's notice, for the cancellation of the Services, including re-connection to the original Service Provider. After receipt of New Customer's timely notice, XO, in conjunction with the termination of New Customer's Service, will waive any applicable contract termination charges.

XO also will reimburse the New Customer for any installation charges incurred by New Customer to restore the New Customer to its previous Service Provider at the identical level and type of service provided by the previous Service Provider at the same customer location. In order to receive the reimbursement, the New Customer must, within (3) months of the installation date, provide XO with the following: (1) the XO reimbursement form; (2) a copy of the invoice from the other Service Provider posting the non-recurring charges for restoring New Customer's service to the other Service Provider; and (3) a copy of the last invoice that the New Customer had received from the other Service Provider prior to switching to XO, if applicable.

This promotion is not available to customers receiving non-standard pricing, non-standard products, or non-standard terms and conditions (e.g., individual case basis prices, products, or terms and conditions), or customers for whom XO performed Special Construction or Special Configurations. Special Construction is defined in Section 2.7 of this tariff. Special Configuration refers to the situation in which a customer's service connection is established through a non standard network architecture design.
